### Complicated Grief:

This term “complicated” refers to factors that interfere with the natural grieving process, such as those associated with traumatic losses due to accident, murder, manslaughter or suicide. This course examines the factors specific to traumatic loss. Our experienced trainers will help you to understand the complexities of such bereavements and the different ways that you can support children and young people in this situation.

- Provide a thorough understanding of complicated grief
- Explain the impact this type of grief may have on a child and their family
- Explore ways to communicate helpfully with children who are experiencing complicated grief
